


## TSE x64 Bit Post Installation Steps

### Re-register the "MSADO25.TLB" file

*This process needs to be performed on all TSE Web servers if you cannot access the Console or Launchpad sites*

- 1) In the TSE 6.0 media you will see a folder called TOOLS under SUPPORT. This folder contains a file called REGTYPELIB.exe. This file is needed to register the MSADO25.TLB file
- 2) Copy the "regtypelib.exe" file to the root of the C: drive
- 3) Run this command:

Regtypelib "C:\program files\Common Files\System\ado\msado25.tlb"

## NMTSEControl.exe (Windows 2003 Servers)

***This file must be present on all TSE app servers in the correct directory***

- 1) Browse to C:\Windows\SysWOW64 and locate the “NMTSEControl.exe” file
- 2) Copy that file to C:\Windows\System32. (Be sure to COPY and not MOVE!!)

~~This will allow users to launch applications

## NMTSEControl.exe (Windows 2008 Servers)

- 1) Browse to C:\Windows\SysWOW64 and locate the “NMTSEControl.exe” file
- 2) Copy that file to C:\Windows\System32. (Be sure to COPY and not MOVE!!)
- 3) Open the TS Remote App Manager tool
- 4) Add a RemoteApp Program for “C:\Windows\System32\NMTSEControl.exe” (See screenshot below)
